

Subject: Generosity

Time Frame: 35-60 mins

GENEROUS GARDNER

As students develop into Generous Gardeners, they hone their self awareness, social awareness and personal relationship skills. Through interactive games and self-expression, students gain an understanding of Generosity by thinking about others, wanting to help them, and being kind and caring to make them happy. Students experience how to give their gifts of Time, Talent and Words in relevant, age appropriate role play. Learn about Generosity in short, fun and easy to follow lesson plans for grades 2, 3 and 4.







Why does George demonstrate **GENEROSITY?**

Since Lizzie is a great dancer, after school she helps Katesha learn the dance steps for the talent show.

How does Lizzie show her GENEROSITY?

Show your Super Crew World Changing POWER!

Cross your hands at your chest and then swing them out in front of you to show you are giving and sharing

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


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


GOODNESS GARDEN
